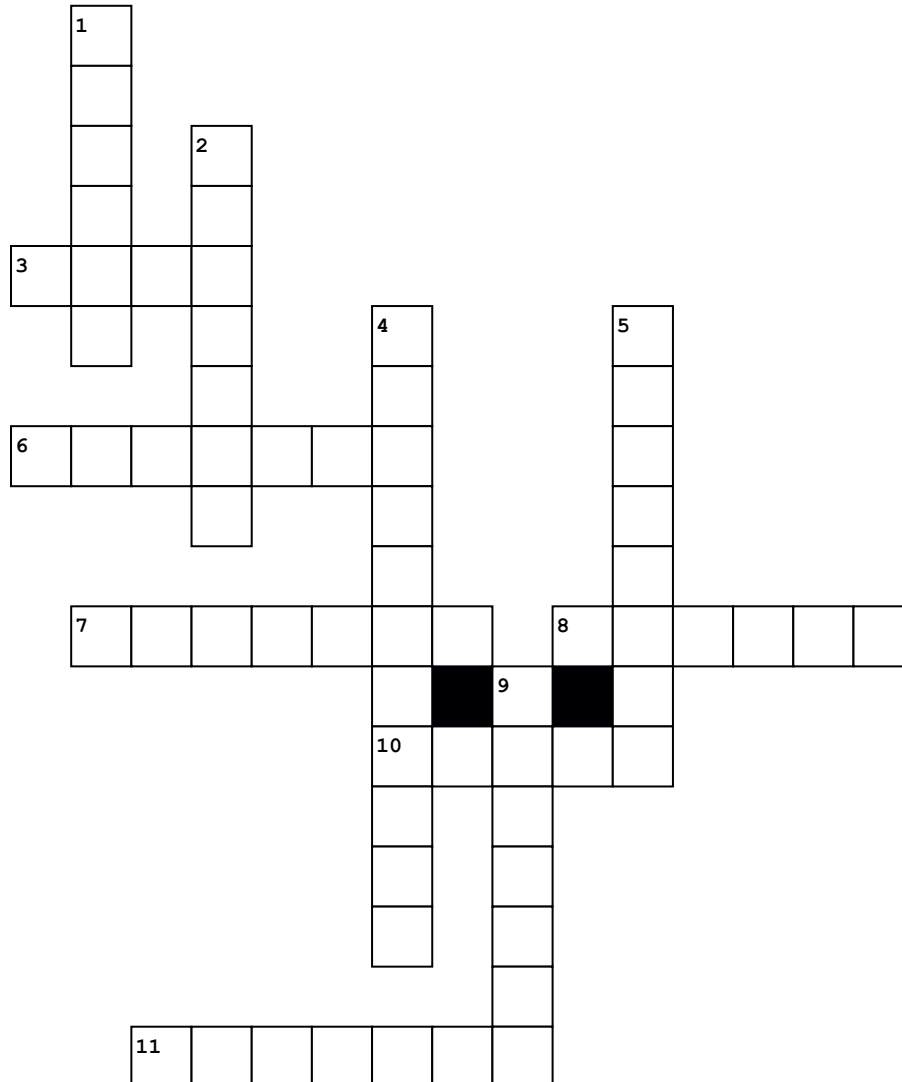


# 1918 flu and SD suffrage movement
